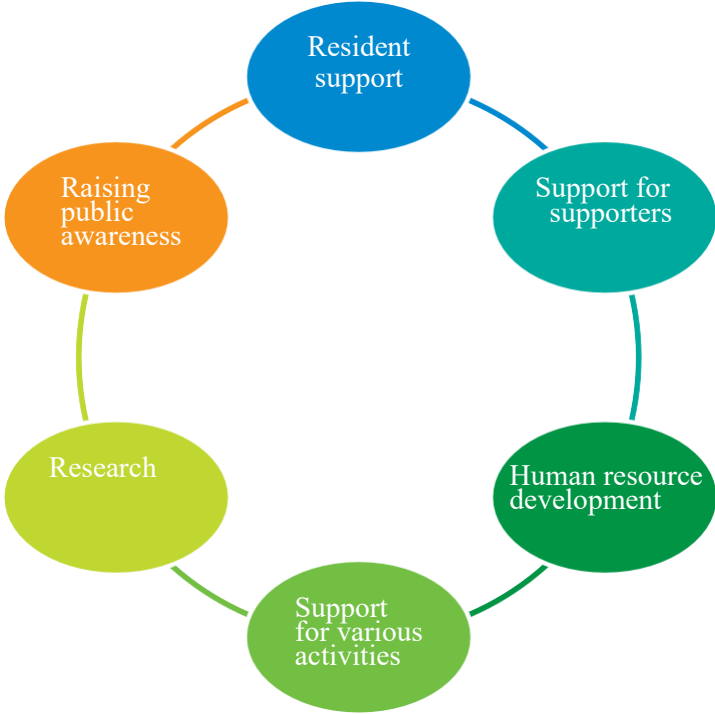


Miyagi Disaster Mental Health Care Center Project

This bulletin primarily contains reports of activities in these six areas.



Resident support

Preventive mental health care, mental wellness counseling, and support for disaster victims

Counseling and support services for victims (one-on-one counseling, telephone counseling, etc.)

Community programming and event planning for residents of disaster areas

Mental and physical health support services for municipal staff, provisional support workers, and other support providers
