

Regarding emergency temporary housing...

- Housing provided by prefectures based on the Disaster Relief Act to secure housing for affected households who have no housing due to their houses being destroyed, burned down, or washed away by the Great East Japan Earthquake.
- The Emergency Rescue Act envisioned the construction of emergency temporary housing (container type temporary housing), but the damage from the Great East Japan Earthquake was extensive and widespread, and many people lost their housing. The prefecture leased private rental properties and provided them with “apartment type temporary housing” as an equivalent to container type temporary housing. Besides, existing housing resources such as public housing were treated in the same way and were used effectively.

- Of the disaster-owned public housing companies that have begun operations, construction has begun for 21 municipalities, 192 districts, 10,292 units (+1,317 units compared to the end of last month), and for 21 municipalities, 115 districts, 5,289 units (+2,331 units compared to the end of last month) construction is complete.
- Information such as the location of each housing complex is posted on the homepage of the Reconstruction Housing Development Office.
